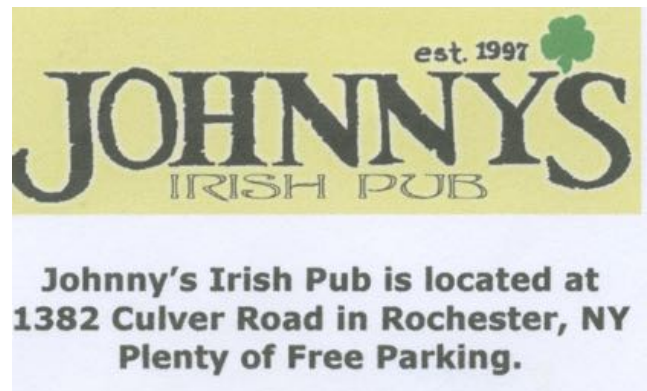
### Great neighbors!
